Whether your project is still an idea or is already at an advanced stage of development, you can apply. Applications are welcome from:

- Local authorities, municipalities and communes
- Small businesses and enterprises
- Energy communities (existing or new)
- NGOs and social economy actors (e.g. cooperatives, associations)
- Groups of citizens (informally or formally organised)

Types of Support Available

Support Type	What You Get
Financial advisory support	Tailored financial planning, early-stage investments, fundraising strategies, and boosting financial literacy.
Technical support	Technical and technology design, regulatory frameworks, digital solutions, and communication strategies.
Legal support	Legal structuring and governance, statutes and governance rules, contracting and regulatory compliance.
Stakeholder engagement	Supports inclusivity through community dialogues, behavioural insights, and targeting underrepresented groups.
Capacity-building support	Energy-sharing, consumer protection, support schemes, and long-term skills development.

Pathways to Support

Selected beneficiaries will receive assistance through one of three dedicated pathways, each designed to meet projects at their specific stage of development:

- **Pilot Beneficiaries:** Advanced-stage projects needing support to launch well-developed, high-potential projects.
- **Learner Beneficiaries:** Mid-stage projects needing to refine ideas and assess feasibility.
- **Follower Beneficiaries:** Early-stage projects seeking direction for design and conception.

Additional Benefits

All beneficiaries have the opportunity to take part in a twinning programme, which fosters learning by linking projects across countries and stages of development. They can also join capacity building workshops that provide practical tools and insights. Participants will explore policies and best practices, access resources and network - for ongoing learning and impact.
